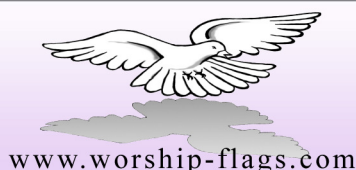

## Prophetically releasing visually what is happening in the spiritual realm in the contexts of worship and intercession.

This can be done through a variety of visual mediums such as dance, flags, mime, acting, drawing and painting etc...

Biblical examples:

- ◆ Moses parting the Red Sea. Exodus 14:21
- ◆ Moses holding up his hands and Joshua prevailing in battle with the Amalekites. Exodus 17:10.
- ◆ Noah building an ark for the covenant of the salvation of man. Genesis 6:18
- ◆ Elisha picking up Elijah's Mantle. II Kings 2:13
- ◆ Jesus on the cross. John 19:18

These acts all came out of people's relationships with God, hearing His voice and acting in obedience to Him.

**It is time for us to come to a new level of hearing the voice of the Spirit of God.**

What are some hindrances to us hearing the voice of the Spirit of God?

- ◆ Self doubt
- ◆ Unbelief
- ◆ Fear
- ◆ Offence
- ◆ Criticism

### 1) Self doubt

Movie The Incredibles. Elastagirl says to her daughter Violet after crashing on a volcanic island: "Self doubt is a luxury we can no longer afford."

I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me. (Philippians 4:13)

### 2) Unbelief

And Jesus said to them, Because of your unbelief. For truly I say to you, If you have faith like a grain of mustard seed, you shall say to this mountain, Move from here to there. And it shall move. And nothing shall be impossible to you. (Matthew 17:20)

### 3) Fear

If you shall say in your heart, These nations are more than I; how can I throw them out? You shall not be afraid of them, but shall well remember what Jehovah your God did to Pharaoh and to all Egypt. Remember the great temptations which your eyes saw, and the signs, and the wonders, and the mighty hand, and the stretched-out arm by which the Lord your God brought you out. So shall Jehovah your God do to all the people of whom you are afraid. (Deuteronomy 7:17-19)

And you shall chase your enemies, and they shall fall before you by the sword. And five of you shall chase a hundred, and a hundred of you shall put ten thousand to flight. And your enemies shall fall by the sword in front of you. For I will have respect to you, and make you fruitful, and multiply you, and establish My covenant with you. (Leviticus 26:7-9)

It is powerful when we are in right relationships in the body of Christ.

### 4) Offence

Hannah went to the temple to travail in prayer with God and was accused by Eli of being drunk. I Samuel 1:19

She did not take offence but rather replied in such a way that the Priest blessed her and asked that God grant her request.

### 5) Criticism

The Priest Eli raising Samuel. Eli's own sons were out of line and uncorrected.

Eli would be easy to criticize. Samuel hears the voice of God and doesn't know what it is and goes to Eli for council. Even though Eli hasn't given his own sons the direction needed he gives Samuel directions that enable Samuel to grow in the knowledge of the Lord and become a great prophet.

And Jehovah called Samuel again, the third time. And he arose and went to Eli and said, Here am I, for you called me. And Eli saw that Jehovah had called the child. And Eli said to Samuel, Go, lie down; and it shall be, if One calls you, you shall say, Speak, Jehovah, for Your servant hears. And Samuel went to lie down in his place.

(1 Samuel 3:8-9)

**Rise up and be the church – the bride, provoke unbelievers to jealousy and bring/establish/expand His kingdom where we are.**

(Matthew 3:2)

**Walk in authority – be in right relationship**

Behold, I give to you authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the
